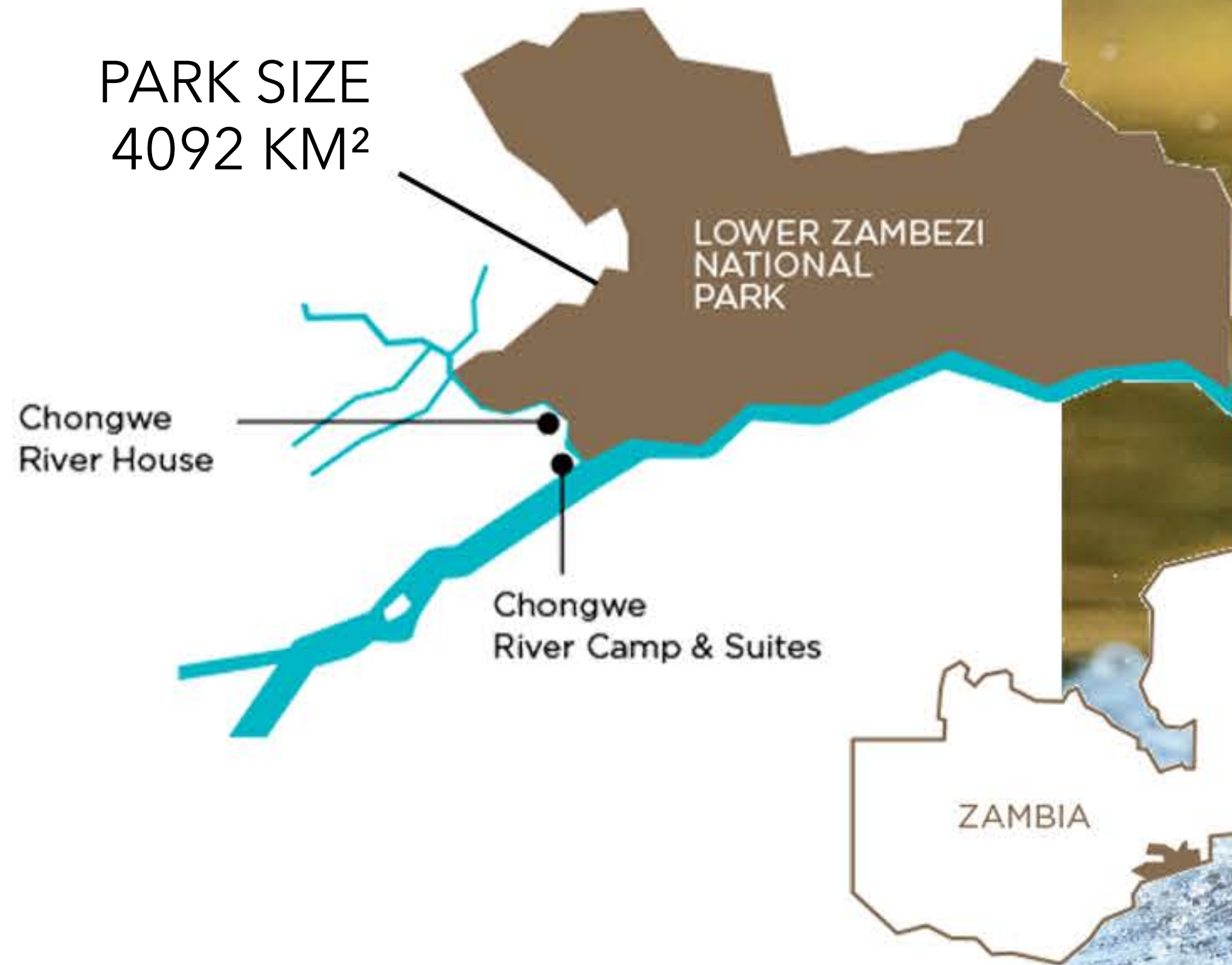

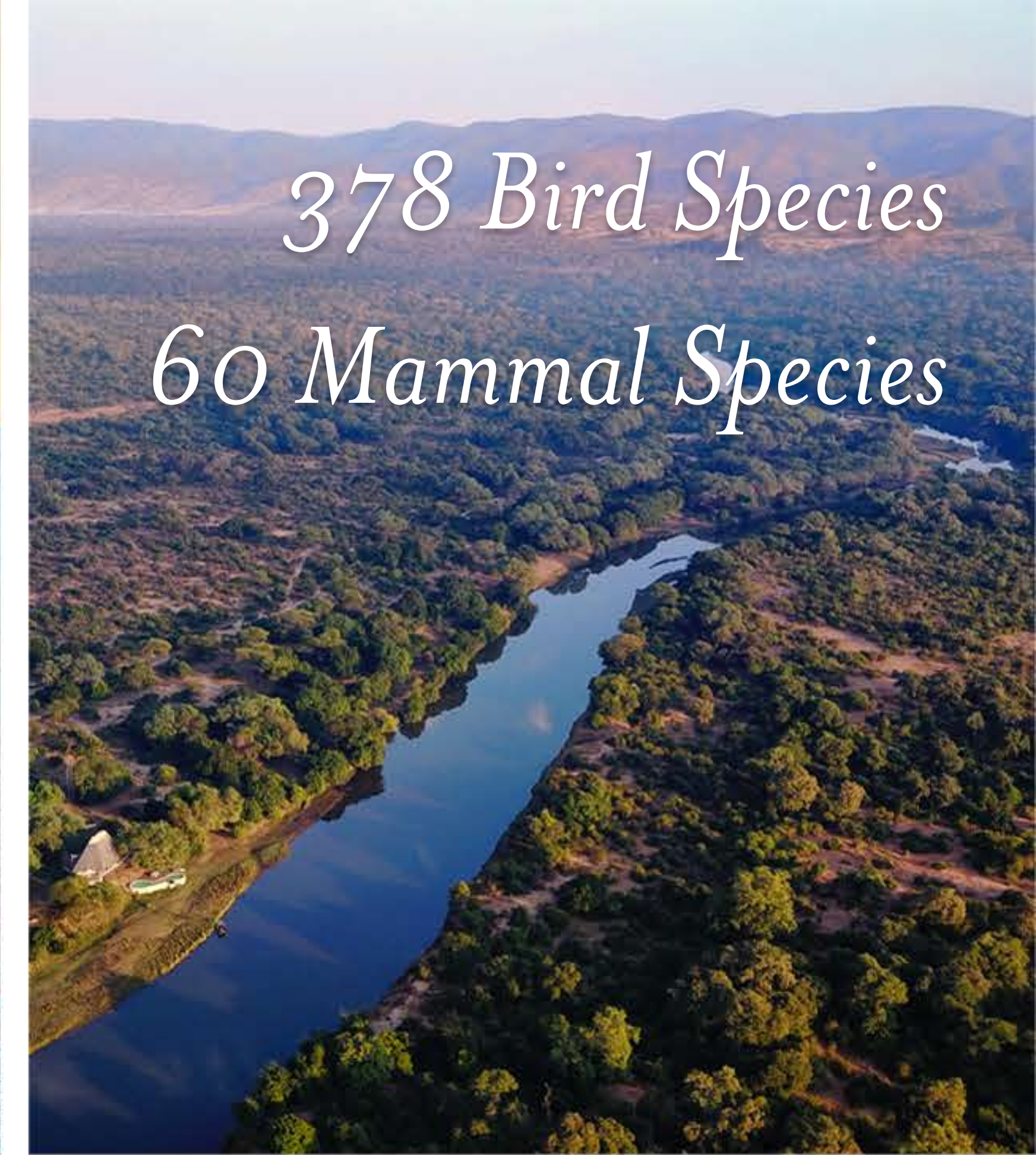

LOWER ZAMBEZI NATIONAL PARK

Flanked by the escarpment on one side and the mighty Zambezi River on the other, Lower Zambezi National Park is an extraordinary wilderness. Lush channels branch from larger rivers and weave through ancient forests, creating a haven for wildlife and birdlife. Wide open pans and tranquil riverbanks create a backdrop for dramatic wildlife action.

The region is especially wonderful for large, relaxed herds of elephants, diverse birdlife, predator encounters, especially endangered wild dogs, and large pods of hippos.

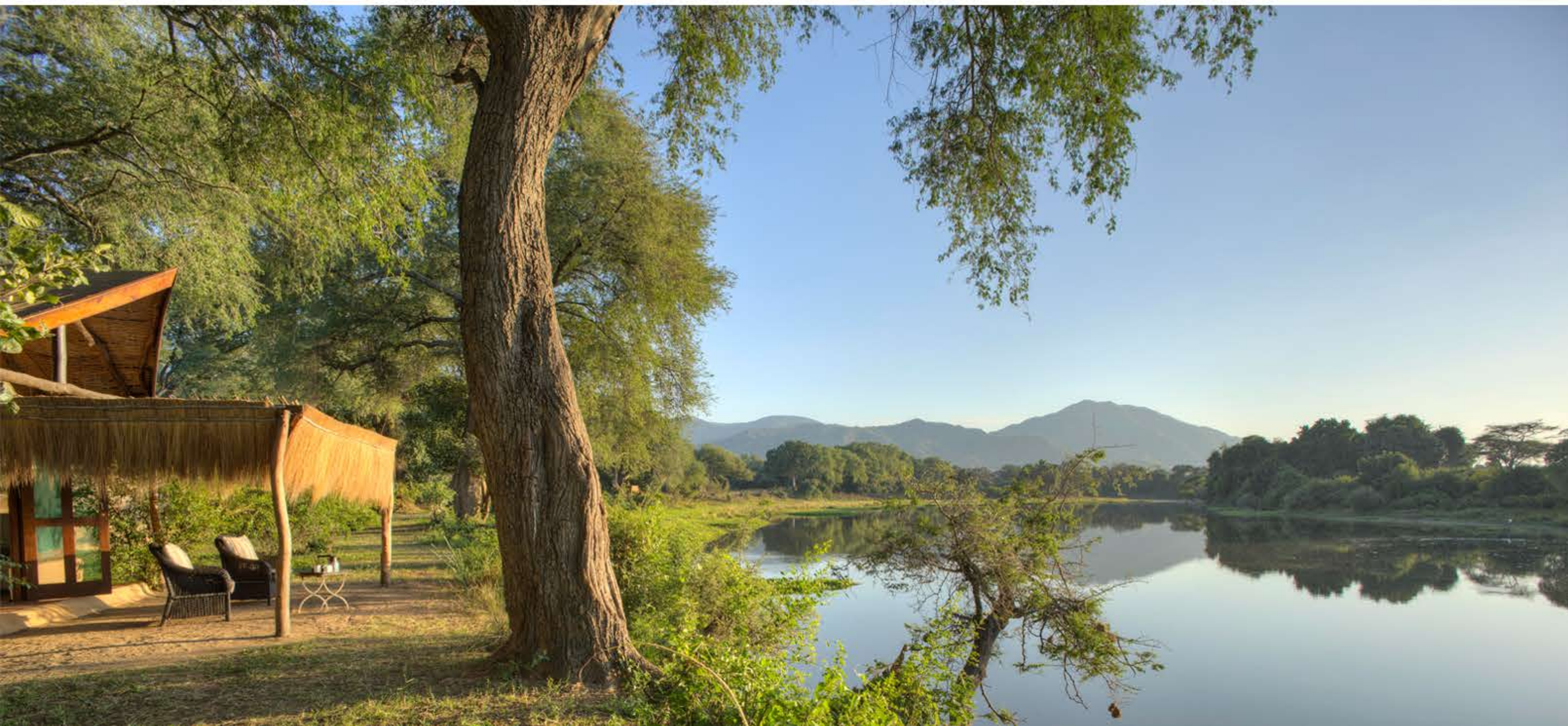
RIVERFRONT SAFARI TENTS

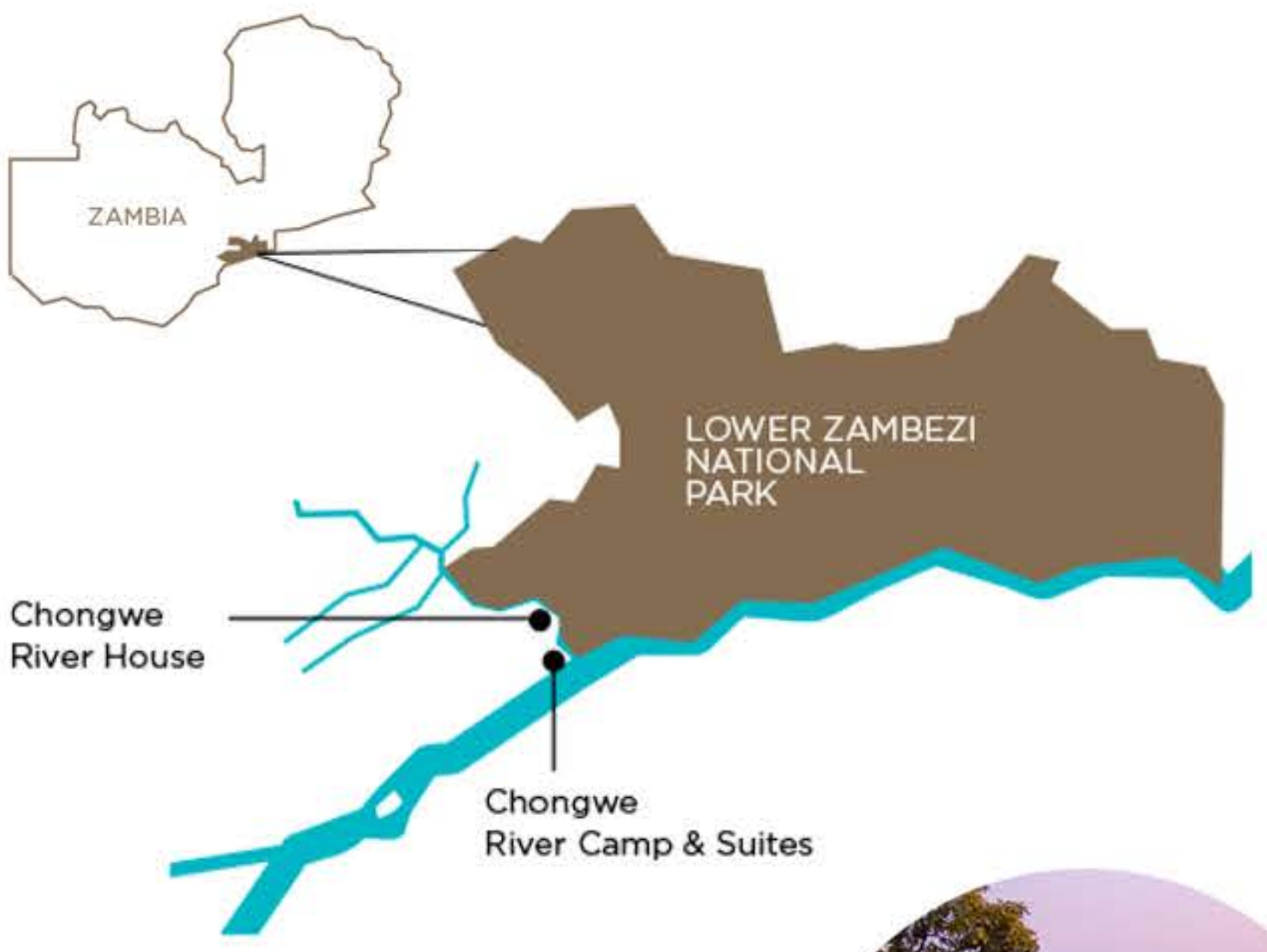

Fishing is good year round, but peaks in October and November during the breeding season.



GREAT ALL SEASON

- + Elephant encounters - experience the touching, intelligent side of these beautiful creatures
- + Birdwatching - over 370 species
- + Boating and canoeing safaris
- + Wildlife photography

July to October is peak season for our Sleepout Under the Stars.



Canoeing safaris are great all year. During the driest months of August to November, wildlife congregates along the river.



Lion and leopard sightings pick up as the bush dries out and the visibility improves.



As the summer rains recede, April is the best time to see wild dogs and a high bird diversity.



Boat cruises are excellent all year on the Zambezi River - expect plenty of hippos, crocodiles, birds + elephants.



The peak walking safari season is July to October.
