Wild dog sightings pick up in late October and November.

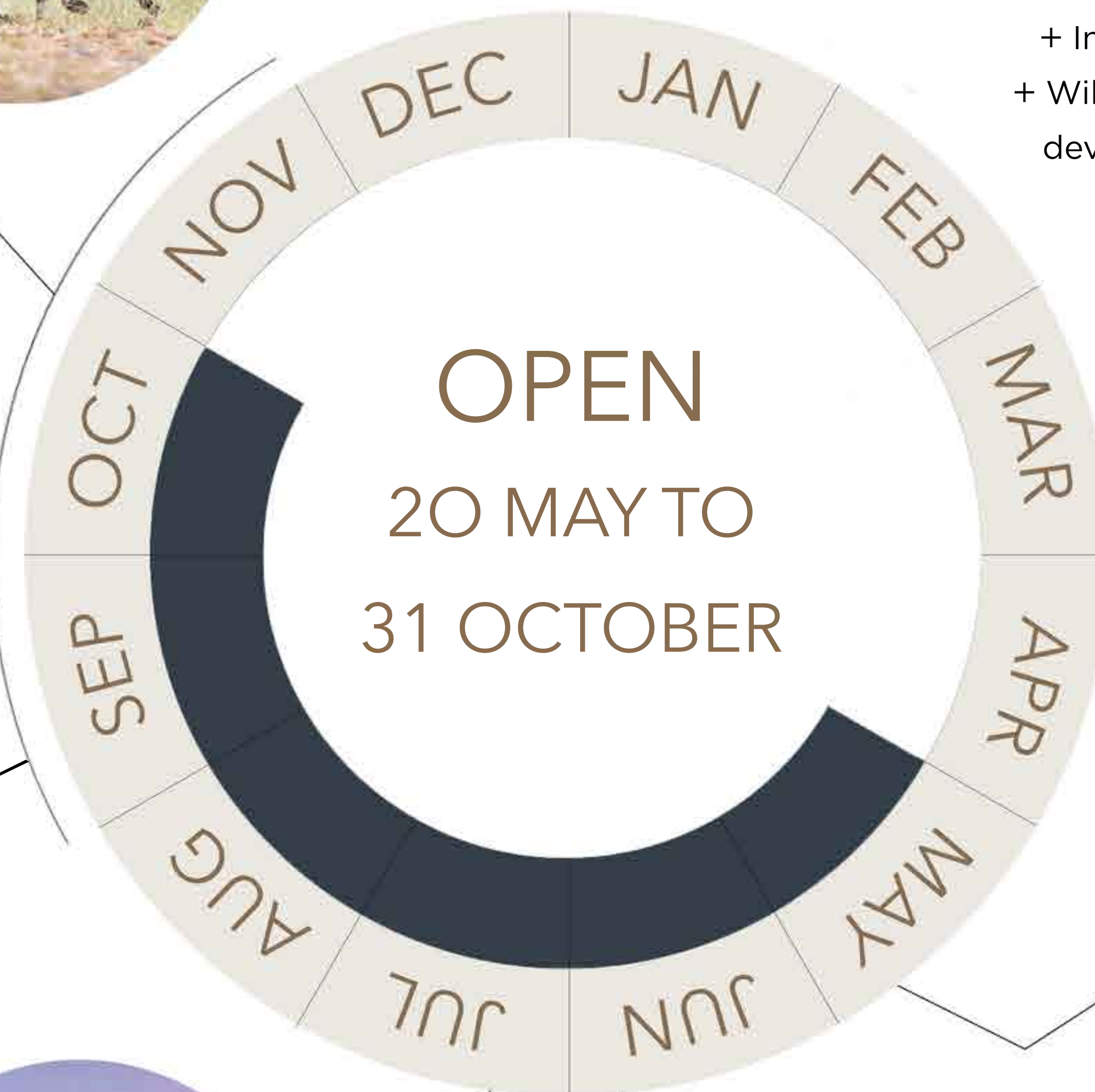
GREAT ALL SEASON

Walking Routes between camps:
Luwi to Nsolo - 9.5 km (2.5 - 3 hours)
Nsolo to Kakuli - 14 km (4 - 4.5 hours)
Nsolo to Mchenja - 12 km (4 hours)
Kakuli to Mchenja - 7km (2 hours)

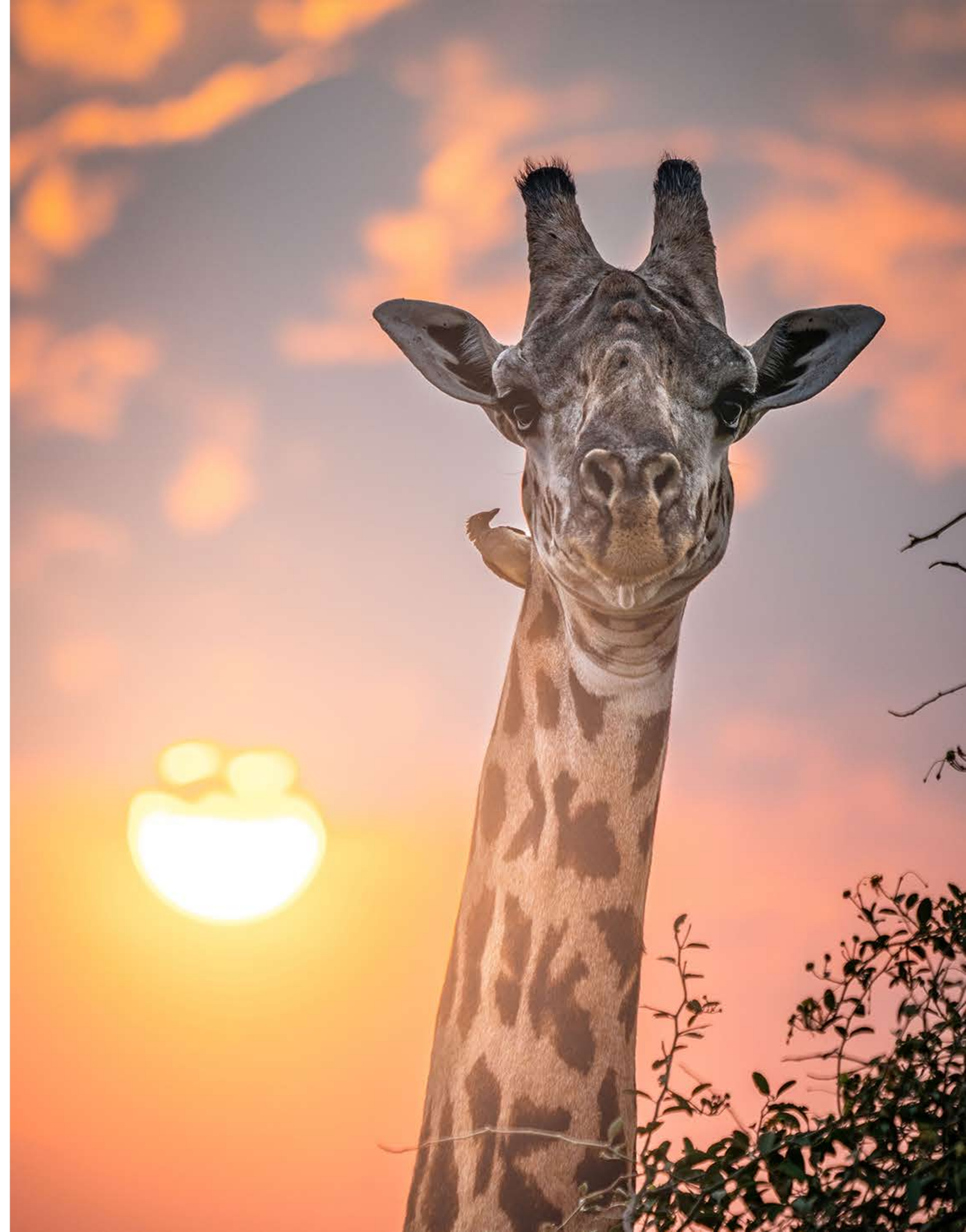
